

Seeking School Counselors in Rural Settings

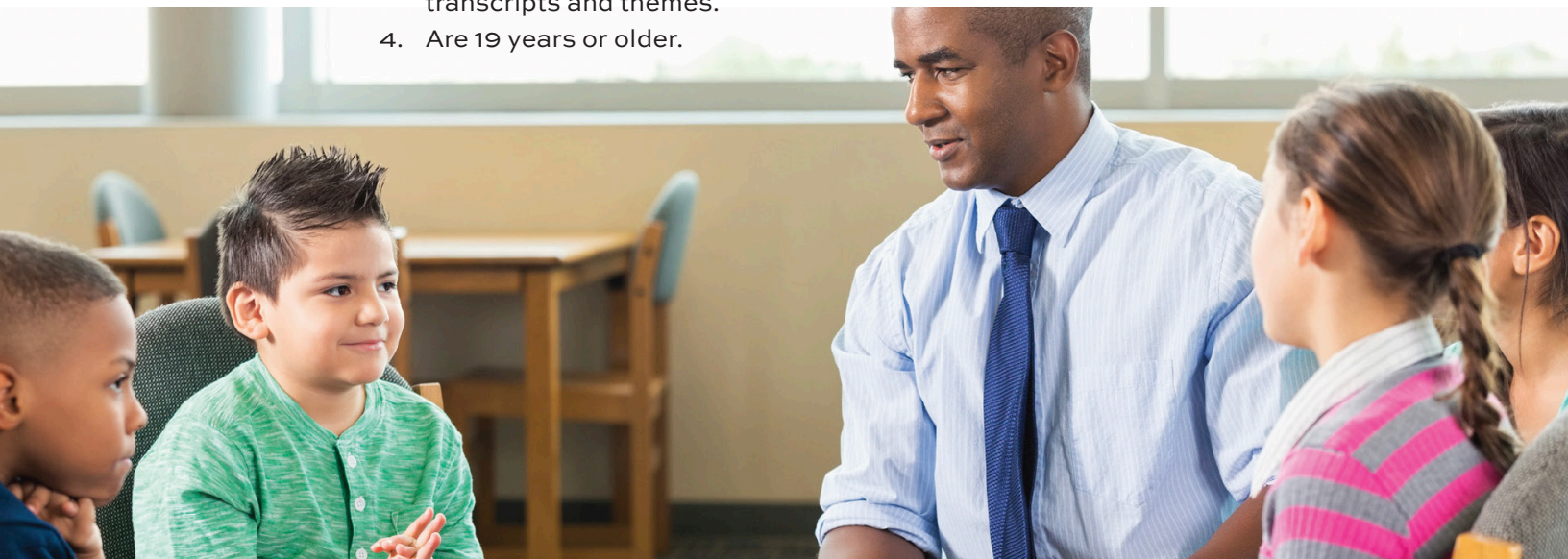
to participate in a research study
